Application Process

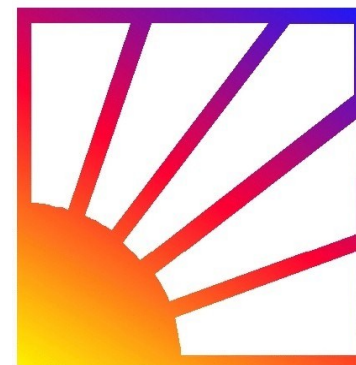
Individuals may apply for the leadership program or a business/organization may nominate an individual who may benefit from participating.
